

Summer Camp Rapid Antigen Testing Enrollment Form

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) has rapid, 15-minute antigen tests available for use by summer camps for screening and diagnostic use. This testing is free for Kansas camps to use but does require enrolling with KDHE and reporting ALL results (positive and negative) to the state within a 24-hour period. A CLIA certificate of waiver is required before testing can take place. This certification can be obtained by the camp itself or the overseeing organization. If an organization has multiple camps throughout the state, only one CLIA certificate of waiver is required for all camps. Alternatively, you may work with your local health department (LHD) to see if you can test under their Certificate of Waiver if that is easier. Testing Strategy

Strategy #1: Regular screening of asymptomatic and unexposed groups

KDHE recommends screening all staff and campers prior to entry to camp. If the camp lasts longer than 2 days, you should also re-test everyone every other day for the duration of the camp.

Strategy #2: Diagnostic testing in staff and campers who become symptomatic
